

Minutes of Plan Commission Meeting April 24, 2007

Held at the Town Hall on County Highway G

Town of Holland, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin

The numbering of the minutes corresponds to that of the Agenda:

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to review a DRAFT questionnaire prepared by consultant David Such, pertinent to the long-range planning process.
2. The assembly recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Chairman Becker certified that the requirements of the Wisconsin Open Meetings law had been met.
4. The Agenda was adopted as the official order of business on a motion by Eugene Schmitz. The motion was supported by Ken Nyhuis and passed by a unanimous voice vote.
5. Roll Call showed in attendance Chairman Donald Becker, Ken Nyhuis, Eugene Schmitz, Dave Huenink, Jan Rauwerdink, and David Mueller. Absent were Claus Weingaertner, John Kucksdorf, and Tom Huenink.
6. David Such handed out copies of previously identified issues, listed in both unranked order and grouped into "smart growth" categories. He further handed out DRAFT 1 of "Town of Holland Smart Growth/Long Range Planning CITIZEN INPUT SURVEY." The latter provided focus of the remainder of the meeting.

The DRAFT 1 CITIZEN INPUT SURVEY was examined in detail, question by question. Some questions were changed, others were dropped altogether. In charge of the edits, Mr. Such is to return DRAFT 2 of the CITIZEN INPUT SURVEY (see attached).

7. The meeting adjourned at 9:40 p.m. on a motion by Donald Becker, supported by David Mueller, passed by a unanimous voice vote.
