

Town of Holland Recycling Center

Recycling and solid waste disposal in the Town of Holland is governed by town ordinances and state statutes. The following will be enforced:

- Use of the Recycling Center is for occupants of Town of Holland residential property (Code 290-14.1). Proof of identification or vehicle registration may be requested and recorded; admittance may be denied.
- Hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays only. Please arrive no later than 3:45 p.m.
- We accept only household trash and recyclable materials; No other items, including construction materials and debris, and solid waste or recyclable materials from manufacturing, commercial, retail, agricultural or other business operations, may be disposed of at the Recycling Facility (Code 290-14.1).
- There are disposal fees for certain items including furniture, appliances, some electronics and Freon appliances. A complete list and fees is online at <http://townofholland.com/resources-2/>.
- Payment of fees is due at time of disposal. We accept only checks and cash, you must have correct amount of cash. We do not accept credit or debit cards or any form of electronic payment.
- Recyclables must be removed from bags or other containers, the empty bags/containers go into the trash compactor (Code 290-16 F).
- Recyclable plastics are generally food containers. They should be rinsed and lids removed (Code 290-14). A complete list of recyclable materials is available at the Recycling Center.
- Medical waste is prohibited per Wisconsin DNR regulations; human or agricultural hypodermic needles, scalpels or other sharp instruments are not allowed.
- We do not accept any ashes from burning barrels, trash fires or open burning (Code 290-19 A). Burning garbage is prohibited by state law due to toxins in plastics, dyes and other materials.
- Compost pile is for leaves, grass clippings, and yard and garden debris (Code 290-10). Plants must be removed from containers; containers go into the trash compactor.
- Brush pile is for clean woody vegetative material no greater than six inches in diameter. We do not accept stumps, roots, or shrubs with intact root balls (Code 290-10).
