1. CALL TO ORDER: The public hearing of the Town of Holland was called to order by Chairman David Huenink at 7:00pm on November 8, 2021. The public hearing was called to discuss the Town of Holland budget proposed for the year 2022.
2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Chair Huenink led the attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. CERTIFY WISCONSIN OPEN MEETING LAW HAS BEEN MET: Clerk-Treasurer Janelle Kaiser certified that the requirements of the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law had been met. A notice and an agenda for the public hearing was posted in three places within the Township and on the Town's website. It was also published in the following local newspapers: the Lakeshore Weekly and The Sounder.
4. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION OF THE 2022 BUDGET: The proposed draft budget was presented. Copies of the 2022 draft budget were available at the meeting.
5. CHAIRMAN TO ASK THREE TIMES IF THERE IS FURTHER COMMENT: Chair David Huenink asked three times for further comment on the 2022 Town of Holland budget. There were no further comments.
6. ADJOURN: Motion by Stanley Lammers, seconded by Douglas Hamilton, to adjourn at 7:18pm; the motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
