

TOWN OF HOLLAND ELECTORS

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT – AUGUST 9, 2022– PARTISAN PRIMARY

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen who:

- will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day
- has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.*

You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing or online at [MyVote.wi.gov](https://www.myvote.wi.gov).

- You may apply for an absentee ballot online at www.myvote.wi.gov
- You may download an application for an absentee ballot at www.elections.wi.gov
- You may contact your municipal clerk to request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you
- You may submit a written request for absentee ballot in the form of a mailed letter, email, or in person to your municipal clerk. **Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, your signature, and a copy of your photo identification*.**

Making an application to receive an absentee ballot by mail

**The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is:
5pm on the fifth day before the election, August 4, 2022**

*Voters who are indefinitely confined due to age, illness, infirmity, or disability may not be required to provide photo ID. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

Voting an absentee ballot in person

You may also vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office during the days and hours specified for casting an absentee ballot in person:

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office: Tuesday, July 26, 2022

The last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office: Friday, August 5, 2022

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close on **August 9, 2022**. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.

Please note that uniform instructions for absentee voting are sent with each absentee ballot. Please read these instructions carefully when completing the absentee ballot certificate envelope in which all ballots must be returned.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE THAT ABSENTEE BALLOTS CAN NO LONGER BE RETURNED TO THE DROP BOX AT THE HOLLAND TOWN HALL.
