1. CALL TO ORDER:
Public Safety Committee Chair Kelly Caswell called to order the public safety committee meeting at 3:00pm.

6. TOWN CODE CHAPTER 140 ANIMALS:
The committee requested that Clerk-Treasurer Janelle Kaiser draft a notice to serve as a public service announcement to property owners and residents of the Town of Holland, as well as anyone who may be renting a property on a short-term basis, to inform them of the requirements of Holland Town Code Chapter 140-2A. which addresses animals running at large. The notice will be provided to 2023 dog license applicants, current short-term rental license holders, and will also be published in a future issue of the Lakeshore Weekly and The Sounder. Information provided by Holland Town Code Chapter 140-2A. should be included on short-term rental licenses beginning in 2023.
7. EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN FOR TOWN OF HOLLAND:
The committee reviewed the latest draft of the emergency operations plan for the Town of Holland at the public safety committee meeting. Motion by Huenink, seconded by Caswell, to recommend that the Holland Town Board adopt the Town of Holland's Emergency Operations Plan with one modification to add an addendum to the plan to include community contacts in the event of an emergency. The emergency operations plan will include business contacts to be used in the event of an emergency. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
