Town of Holland
Public Hearing Minutes
Sheboygan County, Wisconsin
February 8, 2016

The Public Hearing of the Town of Holland was called to order by Supervisor David Huenink at 7:30 p.m. on February 8, 2016.

Those present from the Town of Holland Board were David Huenink, Steve Jones, Stan Lammers, and Martin Elmer. Chairman Don Becker arrived during the hearing. Clerk, Sharon Claerbaut was also present. An attendance sheet shows the names of the public who were in attendance.

Supervisor Huenink explained that the reason for the Public Hearing was to discuss proposed changes to an ordinance. The draft Ordinance is entitled 'Ordinance Amending §263.1 and §263.3 of the Code of the Town of Holland, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin.' This ordinance has to do with Junked Vehicles and Appliances, and the revision as drafted includes the applicability to farm machinery.

About 15 town residents were present and several objected to the inclusion of farm machinery in the ordinance. Some good points were expressed relative to determining applicability and enforcement. There were also some objections to the entire original ordinance citing freedom to use one's property as they choose.

After much discussion, there was a motion by Don Becker, seconded by Steve Jones, to adjourn. Motion carried. Public Hearing adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
