FIREWORKS PERMIT APPLICATION

Fireworks are defined in §167.10(1), Wis. Stats., as ... *"fireworks" means anything manufactured, processed or packaged for exploding, emitting sparks or combustion which does not have another common use...* A number of notable exclusions are provided in this ordinance including a:

- Fuel
- Firearm cartridge
- Flare
- Match, candle, or heater
- Cap containing not more than one-quarter grain of explosive mixture, and
- Certain other toys and related products

See §167.10(1), Wis. Stats., for a complete listing of exclusions.

Ordinance 174-3 A. *No person may possess or use fireworks without a user's permit from the Town Board or from an official or employee of the Town as designated by the Town Board.*

Ordinance 174-3 C. *Whom permit may be issued to. A permit under this section may be issued only to the following:*

- (1) A public authority*
 - (2) A fair association*
 - (3) An amusement park*
 - (4) A park board*
 - (5) A civic organization*
 - (6) A group of resident or nonresident individuals*
 - (7) An agricultural producer for the protection of crops from predatory birds or animals*
