OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING TO ADDRESS THE 2026 BUDGET

Monday, November 5, 2025 6:00pm

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The public hearing of the Town of Holland was called to order by Chairman David Huenink at 6:00pm on November 5, 2025. The public hearing was called to discuss the Town of Holland budget proposed for the year 2026.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Chair Huenink led attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. CERTIFY WISCONSIN OPEN MEETING LAW HAS BEEN MET:

Clerk-Treasurer Janelle Kaiser certified that the requirements of the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law had been met. A public hearing notice to include a summary budget and other required information was posted in three places throughout the Town and on the Town's website on October 17, 2025. It was also printed in the Lakeshore Weekly and The Sounder. The agenda for the public hearing was posted at the Holland Town Hall and on the Town's website.

4. ADOPT AGENDA AS OFFICIAL ORDER OF BUSINESS:

Motion by Brody Stapel, seconded by Gordie Seegert, to adopt the agenda for the November 5, 2025 public hearing as presented; the motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

5. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION OF THE 2026 BUDGET:

A summary of the proposed 2026 Town budget was presented by Chair Huenink. Copies of the 2026 draft budget detail were made available to attendees of the hearing. A few members of the public asked questions about budget-related items, such as the Town's receipt and use of shared revenue funds to include utility aid, professional legal expenses, and adequate funding for road projects and first responders. One member of the public asked about a prior year budget amendment. Chair Huenink and Clerk/Treasurer Janelle Kaiser provided responses to questions. Chair Huenink also discussed funds allocated to the Town's broadband services improvement designated reserve.

6. CHAIRMAN TO ASK THREE TIMES IF THERE IS FURTHER COMMENT:

Chair David Huenink asked three times for further comment on the 2026 Town of Holland budget. There were no further comments.

7. ADJOURN:

Motion by Brody Stapel, seconded by Douglas Hamilton, to adjourn the public hearing at 7:13pm; the motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
